### Science Teacher Primary Responsibilities:

## Full-time Position

There is a potential for full time employment that pairs teaching responsibilities (outlined above) with program responsibilities.

### **Program Staff Primary Responsibilities:**

- Staff daily program afternoons including climbing, mountain biking, boating, skiing, PE classes, individual workout, and group games
- Staff backcountry backpacking, climbing, canyoneering, mountain biking, boating, skiing, and winter camping field programs (averaging one week/month in the field)
- Staff an international field program in January
