

Resident Assistant and Program Staff

Full-time Position

Residential Assistant Primary Responsibilities:

- Provide around the clock care for students in their living environment
- Develop community and individual relationships to ensure a safe, love-filled environment
- Oversee kitchen operations, meal preparation, and clean up
- Manage and clean lodging facilities
- Facilitate conflict resolution
- Conduct disciplinary action as needed
- Communicate with families as needed

Program Staff Primary Responsibilities:

- Staff daily program afternoons including climbing, mountain biking, boating, skiing, PE classes, individual workout, and group games
- Staff backcountry backpacking, climbing, canyoneering, mountain biking, boating, skiing, and winter camping field programs (averaging one week/month in the field)
- Staff an international field program in January
- Contribute to field program preparation and derig
- Mentor one-three students completing individualized projects
- Maintain a driver's license and the ability to drive a 9-15 passenger vehicle with trailer
- Maintain Wilderness First Aid or higher certification
- Attend staff training in August, January, and June

Minimum Qualifications:

- High school diploma
- Four years post-high school academic or work experience
- Mental and physical endurance
- Authentic Christian Science practice

Preferred Qualifications:

- BA degree
- Relevant experience
