

# High School Spanish Teacher

The Link School is seeking an energetic, compassionate, and practiced classroom teacher to instruct high school Spanish classes beginning Fall 2026.

Teachers at The Link School enjoy autonomy and the opportunity to implement creative ideas in their classrooms. At the same time, teachers are diligent, focused, prepared, and purpose-driven. The blend of creativity and professionalism makes for a rewarding workplace. Teachers receive ready support from attentive, present administrators. Additionally, teachers are actively encouraged to maintain balance and inspiration for the classroom through paid prep periods and regular time off while students and program staff are on expeditions.

The Spanish teacher at The Link School is a vital member of our core teaching team. Spanish language is an integral part of The Link School’s culture, and students and staff can often be heard conversing in or practicing Spanish outside of the classroom. Spanish is taught Monday-Thursday from 8:50-11:50am and Friday from 8:50-10:30am. Classes are leveled from Beginner Spanish to Advanced Spanish/Spanish Lit based on students’ previous learning and experience. In addition to teaching in the classroom, the Spanish teacher plays an active role in preparing students for our January international trip and in modeling speaking Spanish in daily life.
